Officer Reports:

Bill Mansfield was not in attendance, but sent in his reports via email: Membership is at 81 members, versus 77 last year. We have 29 float fliers. There was no safety related news.

Webmaster Mike Gulizia was not in attendance, so there was no report thereon.

Float Fly coordinator Ken Jochim reported that float flying has been very good the past few weeks, with excellent weather and a good turnout. The new boat procedure is to bring the boat to the parking lot, but not unload it unless it is needed, which saves time and effort since we had few crashes recently. Ken also mentioned the new lock on the boat, which was shared with the float fliers in an earlier note.

New Business:

Ken Jochim noted that one of the barrels under a pit table is split and wobbling. Greg will check into where we might purchase a replacement. Once we have one, a work party will be scheduled.

It was reported that a club member has been sitting on the helicopter flight pad and flying a drone well out of line of sight, which is in violation of club, AMA, and FAA rules. The person was been informed by one of the members, and will be contacted by one of the officers to discuss the matter.
