Greg has arranged for a notice about Dean Chandler in the AMA Model Aviation magazine District IX News, and also have his name added to the AMA Final Flights section. He believes that something will be published in the August magazine.

Greg talked to Superior Aggregates about the resurfacing. The cost for crack fill on the runway and taxiway, top seal on the runway, and repainting the stripes will be \$7422. This was approved and will be scheduled for September.

The city provided Red Flag Warning sign now has the correct address and is posted on the front gate.

New Business:

Joe Sherran discovered that small bees were nesting in the charging station plugs. He cleaned them out and put covers on the plugs. Thanks to Joe for doing that. Be sure to replace the plug covers after you're finished charging up.
