Minutes:

President Wendell Wickstrom called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm. Wendell gave the following Treasurer's report:

Wendell asked that all club members refrain from throwing trash in the porta-potti. We should all be on the lookout for others that may put trash in it. We may not be able to get it pumped, if there are cans and trash in it.

Wendell explained the E Mail from Chris Dropinski, which explained that most likely the BAS would not have to move.

Wendell introduced Doug Hawthorn, of the Parks & Rec Department. Mr. Hawthorn explained that on Thursday evening, August 31, the Parks & Recreation Advisory Board will vote on the transfer of the park properties. He explained that the property around Boulder Reservoir would not be a part of the transfer and would remain under Parks & Recreation.

Mr. Hawthorn went on to explain that BAS has leased the activity for many years, but not the land itself. He suggested that the lease should be changed to a lease of the land, possibly allowing BAS to get money from other users. When questioned about a long term lease, he explained that three years would be the maximum length of a lease. Mr. Hawthorn stated that the philosophy is to keep the land

surrounding the reservoir in a natural state. He went on to say that he would like to have a plan to manage the prairie dogs.

Wendell announced the next meeting would be at the Vo Tech Center on 6600 E. Arapahoe, at 7:30 p.m.


Notes
