

BAS CLUB MEETING - Minutes

June 9, 2021

It was reported the Gutter repair is mostly complete. A test after the first repair indicated a couple of additional areas for patches. Ken and Murray will take care of it. It was agreed that the next time it starts leaking, we will look into replacing it with a seamless gutter which has the proper pitch, so it will drain properly.

David Hirsch was not available, so there is no update on the audit. David should be available for the July meeting.

New Business:

It was suggested that Aidan contact the city re: the SW quadrant, since no new signs have shown up.

The question of a BBQ and/or fun fly this summer was raised. It was proposed that we poll the members and see if there is any interest. Previous events have had marginal attendance.
