#### BAS Meeting Minutes - 1/11/2017 Hobytown Longmont

The meeting was called to order by Secretary Ken Jochim at 6:30 pm.

There were 8 members present.

It was moved by Mike Gulizia and seconded by Rudy Glick that the minutes of the previous meeting be approved as published. Motion passed.

There were no reports from the elected officers.

Al Coelho reported we now have 52 members/renewals for the 2017 year, with 18 in the float fly subgroup.

A discussion was held regarding the BAS retrieval boat ownership and registration for the coming year. The registration needs to be started fairly soon. Rich Anderson asked that he be allowed to retire from this responsibility after many years of service. An email will be sent by the

secretary to all the members of the float fly subgroup asking for a volunteer for this duty.

It was noted that a work party will be scheduled when it gets warmer to do the maintenance on the boat and trailer. Mike Gulizia has obtained a new set of LED tail lights for the trailer. Also the wheel bearings need to be lubricated, and perhaps some sealing of the rivets/seams could be done to reduce the leakage.

Mike Morter has ordered a solar charging system for the boat battery during storage. It was agreed that the float fly subgroup should offer to reimburse Mike for that expense.

There being no further new or old business, it was moved by Al Coelho that the meeting be adjourned at 6:55 pm. Motion passed.

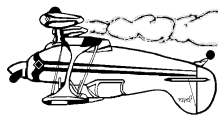
