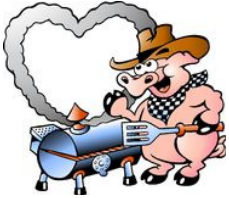

Minutes, BAS Club Meeting – 6/14/2017 Club Field

The meeting was called to order at 6:31 by Vice-President Chester Shans.

There were 7 members and one new member present.

There was no Secretary's report, since Ken Jochim was not present.

Dean Ehn gave the Treasurer's report.

Al Coelho gave the membership report. There are now 79 members, with 2 new this month. Float fly participation is at 26 members. Al indicated that membership growth after this point in the year typically falls off. Wendell asked about the 19 people who have not renewed and if we were still planning on reaching out to them. Any activity on that project will be delayed until next month. Al noted that he already does contact all members to remind them to renew and then again to remind them that they will no longer receive the BAS newsletter.

BAS Picnic – The picnic is scheduled for July 29th, starting at 10:00 am. David Goodnow has already arranged for catering by Dickies BBQ. Al Coelho will put the list of food items to be at the picnic in the next newsletter. Chester Shans will check with David to see if any other supplies are needed for the picnic.

Weed Control – Rich Anderson has the weed killer necessary to get this done. Once Rich establishes a schedule for spraying, he and Al Coelho will do the work. Al will send a note when the date is set so club members know.

Web Site - Chester Shans pointed out that the BAS main page still referenced providing a gate key to new members. Mike Gulizia committed to fix the page to use the word "access" instead, which would cover any technique that BAS may use in the future.

Drones – Chester brought up that Joy Master, Boulder Parks and Recreation, had talked to a drone flier who was not a member, and was flying at the field

alone. She was interested to know how he got in. The expectation is that a member was at the field when the non-member arrived, and then the member left. Chester indicated that Murray had responded to Joy with an explanation of how that might have happened.

Reservoir South Shore Recreation Plan – Chester informed us that there is a meeting to discuss the plan on July 5th from 5:00 to 7:00 pm. Chester thought that he and Murray would likely attend to represent the club.

New Member - Brian Straight was the new member at the June meeting. Brian flies a drone, a DGI M600, and does research at CU. He's working on a project developing the components to adapt drones to do water sampling. Brian has an engineering background.

FAA Drone Registration - There was some discussion on status of this process. Although FAA registration is not currently required, it is thought that AMA and FAA are actually still discussing it.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:03 pm.

What happened on July 4th 1776?

We celebrate American Independence Day on the Fourth of July every year. We think of July 4, 1776, as a day that represents the Declaration of Independence and the birth of the United States of America as an independent nation.

But July 4, 1776 wasn't the day that the Continental Congress decided to declare independence (they did that on July 2, 1776).

It wasn't the day we started the American Revolution either (that had happened back in April 1775).

And it wasn't the day Thomas Jefferson wrote the first draft of the Declaration of Independence (that was in June 1776).

Or the date it was signed (that was August 2, 1776).

Or the date on which the Declaration was delivered to Great Britain (that didn't happen until November 1776).

It was on July 4, 1776 that the Continental Congress approved the final wording of the Declaration of Independence. They'd been working on it for a couple of days after the draft was submitted on July 2nd and finally agreed on all of the edits and changes.

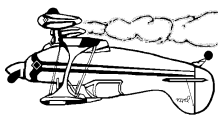
