Flying Field Re-opened!

The flying field has re-opened, with the following COVID-19 precautions consistent with other facilities in Boulder County. In order to curb the spread of the virus, the city has the following protocols for use of the field:

- Don't go to the field if you are sick.
- Bring a mask/face covering. Wearing a mask is always encouraged and is required if you cannot maintain a 6-foot distance from other people.
- Maintain 6 foot distance from others.
- No gatherings of more than 10 people.
- Avoid sharing equipment.

The city is also requesting that we keep the gate closed/locked even when there's a member at the field to prevent non-airfield users from parking in our parking lot. To be clear, as has been required of us for a very long time, any member of the public is still free to use the field if they like.

BAS Meeting Minutes, 4/8/2020

On-line Zoom Meeting

The meeting was held as a Virtual Meeting via a Zoom on line conference.

The meeting was called to order by President Aidan Sesnic at 6:30 pm. There were 12 members in attendance (on line).

The minutes from the prior meeting were approved.

There were no reports from either the Secretary or the Safety Officer.

Dean Ehn reported on the state of the treasury.

Float Fly Coordinator Ken Jochim reported that the all the registrations for the Float Fly boat are available. Ken has the state boat number sticker and the license plate sticker. The Boulder Reservoir sticker will be applied the first time we go out. Currently the reservoir is closed, and the indication is that it may remain closed until June.

Chester Shans reported that we have 66 members as of this date, with 22 float flyers.

Webmaster Mike Gulizia indicated that a note is on the Website and the club membership application regarding the requirement to get approval for Commercial Use of the field. Aidan is going to check with the city to determine what process is involved for the approval.

Old Business

Aidan reported that any activity with regards to Gravel and City Contracts are on hold pending the Covid situation. He also reported no activity by the Airport regarding a new agreement, and that the old agreement remains in force.

The June "Special Meeting" mentioned last meeting minutes will be deferred until we know when the field will be reopened for use.

Regarding the St. Vrain Innovation Center Aerofest, it will be rescheduled to some point later in the

year. Rich Anderson noted that he has the club banner, and Ken Jochim reiterated that he will represent the club when the event occurs.

The city has confirmed they will enforce certain field rules. The Rules involved are the AMA Safety Rules and the prohibition from flying while standing on the runway or any other place outside of the designated pilot stations. Fines may be levied on infractions.

Lost Aircraft Retrieval Training has been deferred until 2021. Folks who were trained previously will continue to be authorized to retrieve aircraft.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 pm.

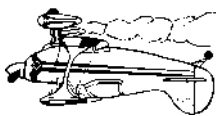
