### BAS Meeting Minutes, 10/13/2020

On-line Zoom Meeting

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by President Aidan Sesnic. There were 10 members present for the on-line video conference.

The minutes of the prior meeting were approved.

There were no reports from the Safety Officer, Webmaster, nor Secretary

Dean Ehn reported on the state of the treasury. Members donated \$2,808 for items from the auction.

Chester Shans reported on the membership. We now have 86 members, 23 of which are float fly subgroup members. This is +6 members versus last year at this time.

Aidan again thanked the Sergeev family for the generous donation of Boris' items for the benefit

of the club. Most of the significant items went to good homes. Thank you cards were signed by a number of members and sent to the family and to the folks at the company where he worked.

It was agreed that we will put some of the smaller items remaining on the counter with a FREE sign, for members to take as desired. Check the counter next time you are at the field. The remaining larger items will be retained for use as give away items at future events.

There was a discussion about the no wake hours at the reservoir. The reservoir is planning on changing what they do in this regard. More next month...

Aidan will talk to the city about putting in more gravel and using a bobcat or similar loader to spread it around.

He also mentioned that there have been more phishing attempts via email to club officers. Beware.

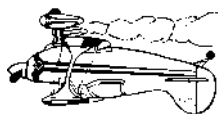

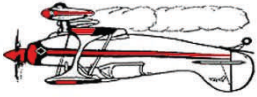
