BAS MEETING MINUTES CHANDLER FIELD BOULDER, CO JUNE 10, 2015

Meeting called to order by **PRESIDENT** Murray Lull at 6:30 pm. with 9 members present.

Motion by Al Coelho with a second to the motion by Ken Jochim to accept the minutes of the last meeting as they appeared in last month's newsletter. Motion was voted on and passed.

SR. ADVISOR — David Goodnow was absent, thus there was no report.

VICE PRESIDENT — Vice President Ken Miller reported on his research regarding the food provider for the upcoming Club picnic. Three main dishes will be purchased as well as Beans, Potato Salad, and perhaps one other side dish. **The date of the Club picnic has been set as July 25, 2015**, 10 am, with food being served at approximately 11:30 am. Members are encouraged to attend the festive activities.

TREASURE REPORT— Dean Ehn gave a detailed report of the clubs finances

SECRETARY — Richard Myron had no report.

MEMBERSHIP — Tom McKinnon reported via President Murray Lull that the club presently has 84 members, with 26 members participating in the float fly activities. The Club has two new members: Dustin Hunt and Belai Hamzeh. Welcome to our new members.

PRESIDENT — Murray Lull stated he had contacted Joy Masters of the City to provide the signs previously voted on during last month's meeting. Joy has agreed to provide said signs. Please note temporary signs have been posted until receipt of the permanent ones does occur. On a side note, members are requested to be diligent when locking the gate so as to not chain it in such a manner as to lock out Reservoir Employees. The City has access through their own lock, and now the combination, but please be mindful of how you attach our lock to the chain. Murray further expressed thanks to Al Coelho, Rich Anderson, and Ken Jochim for their "outreach efforts" with regard to Sunflower Farms.

OLD BUSINESS — A general field workday was scheduled for June 13th, subject to weather, but was subsequently moved to June 20, 2015 at 10 am. The field will be closed to flying on June 20 from 10 am until completion of the needed maintenance work. Members are encouraged to assist. Weed spraying will be scheduled to occur in the future.

Murray stated that he has been looking into the possible AMA requirement that we have a contract with the airport. Although the AMA has indicated they would assist in this matter, nothing further to date has occurred. It was pointed out by Murray that the AMA has stated that they will handle the matter, if we so wish. He indicated that the AMA contact option is probably best for the Club.

NEW BUSINESS — Member Jim Gautreaux brought up a point of Float Fly Safety concern involving spectators and other boaters at the Reservoir during float fly activities. It was decided that the initial approach in such cases should be to politely speak with the group leaders and express our concern for their safety. Motion by Rich Anderson with a second by Wendell Wickstrom to adjourn the meeting. Motion voted on and passed. There is no gift card drawing for meeting held at the field.

SHOW AND TELL: Richard Myron displayed a recently received “laser cut” Giant Aeromaster that had been cut as a birthday present for Richard’s son, Mark Bradley. Vic’s RC, the company listed in our monthly newsletter, had provided not only the cut ribs and formers, but also the fiberglass cowl and wheel pants. Vic does an excellent job and is always pleasant to work with. Vic additionally has a digital foam cutter should you need assistance in that area as well.

Since the June meeting, it was discovered that the field shelter had suffered an act of vandalism from unknown individuals which included the splattering of paint balls and the spraying of what appeared to be fire extinguishers, about the interior/exterior of the shelter. The vandalism was reported to Stacy Cole of the Reservoir who requested we directly contact the Boulder Police, who investigated the matter. Clean up operations were commenced to restore the condition of the shelter. Nothing further has been determined by either the City or the Boulder Police with regard to this vandalism.
