BAS May 13th 2009 Meeting Minutes

In the absence of President Greg Hine Vice President Augie Bruno called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with 19 members and 2 guests present. Augie introduced Wade Kloos owner and operator of Scale Pursuit Models. Wade gave a presentation of his models which are constructed of EPP foam covered with a polycarbonate skin with scale details molded into the skin. He showed the advantages of this type construction and passed out brochures on his products.

TREASURES REPORT--Treasure Ken Jochim gave a detailed report of the clubs financial status.

1st VICE PRESIDENT REPORT-- 1ST Vice President Augie Bruno, reported three new members have joined the club. Their names are Cody Remington, Student member, Alex Neiman, youth member and Asad Hafeez Adult member. The club now has a total of 100 members.

Rich Anderson and Dean Chandler gave a report on the status of the float fly problems. Dean stated we still do not have a state license for the boat. All we have is a temporary license and we need this license before he can get the permit for the lake. The boat trailer needs to be cleaned and painted before it can pass inspection for Zebra Mussels. A discussion was held on who could use the boat at a float fly. A motion was made by Augie Bruno that only BAS members in good standing can use the float fly boat. After more discussion the motion was restated with a second by Rich Anderson .
