BAS Float Fly Safety Protocol

- 1. Exercise common sense and abide by the intent of all normal land field rules where applicable.
- 2. The flying area is directly in front of the beach, well out over the water. There will be no flying over the shore or within 50 feet of the shore (this is the safety distance from spectators and pits).
- 3. If watercraft are approaching the vicinity of the takeoff/landing area, the flying area will be closed to takeoffs. Anyone in the air should either land as soon as possible in a safe area, or be prepared to continue flying until the area is again clear. All float fliers are empowered to make this call and announce it to the group if the situation warrants it.
- 4. Avoid beaching aircraft at high speeds.
- 5. Announce the intention to takeoff or land. Landing aircraft have the right of way.
- 6. Paying the Float Fly sub group fee signifies your agreement with these rules.
