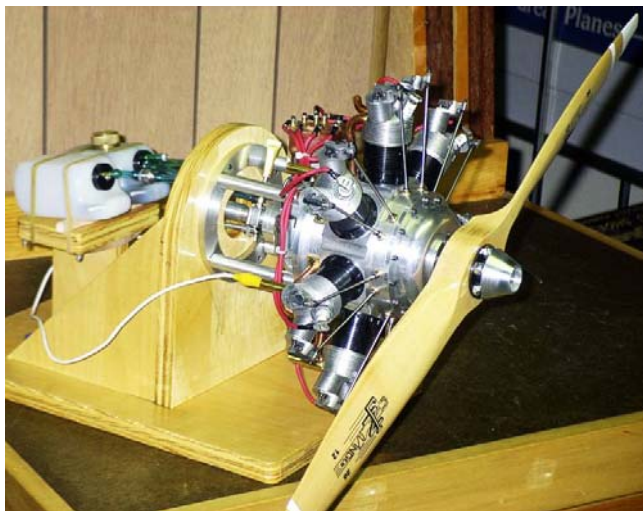
Motion to adjourn was made by Rich Anderson around 8:15pm.
