### **Show And Tell**

Tony Kilwien and Ken Jochim both brought their latest toys: Banchee ARFs by Cermark models.



The planes are powered with brushless electric motors pulling 45amp at full throttle. LiPoly batteries provide enough charge for about 10 minutes of wild 3D flying. The airplanes weigh

approximately 4lbs, while the motor produces 5lbs of thrust. Hmmm, exciting flying.



Boris Sergeev displayed a model he is building—an electric 3D plane by the Stevens AeroModel of Co. Springs called G-Ride:



The plane has 36.5” wingspan and is expected to have AUV of no more than 14 ounces. A 100W brushless setup develops about 20oz static thrust.

The kit has interlocking type construction, which Boris says builds straight and true. Looks good so far Boris.

Glow-flying public was glad to see that there are still non-electric planes in the sky as Bob Franklin displayed a Sig 4 Star 60. He installed a Tower 75 engine for the power. It is done in orange covering, and Bob did a beautiful job.

Wan Suwito placed the following ad:

My advertisement is to help any club members and friends who would like to sell their RC airplane/boat/car kits, radios, and other RC equipment on Ebay. Those who do not know how to sell on Ebay, or those who do not want the hassle of selling on Ebay, could use my service. I can also give some advice on what RC kits or equipment that would sell, and for approximately how much. The item will be listed for 7 days, and it takes another 7 days to complete the transaction. On average, it would take about 2 to 3 weeks to turn a merchandise into cash. My service fee is 20% of the selling price. This includes picture fee, listing fee, Ebay fees, PayPal fees, and S&H fee. At the end, the owner of sold merchandise will get 80% of the final price. This is better than 30% or more they charge at Ebay drop off stores. I use more selling options than those stores, and I specialize in selling RC merchandise. If the merchandise does not sell, the cost to the owner is maximum \$5, or none in most cases, depending on the reserve price. For more information I can be reached at
