BAS Meeting Minutes, 2/13/2019

HobbyTown USA Longmont

The meeting was called to order at 6:30 pm by Secretary Ken Jochim in Aidan Sesnic's absence. There were 6 members present.

A motion to approve the minutes of the previous meeting was made by Al Coelho, seconded by Rudy Glick. Motion passed.

Ken Jochim reported on the state of the club finances for Treasurer Dean Ehn.

Secretary Ken Jochim reported that the new FAA rule that requires FAA registration on the exterior of model aircraft is being implemented. Discussion on the impact and specific parameters of this announcement took place.

Al Coelho reported on membership for Chester Shans. He reported that at this time, 40 membership renewals have been received. This includes 17 in the float fly special interest group. Al noted that the membership number reported did not yet include our lifetime members.

Old Business

Ken relayed that Aidan Sesnic signed our agreement renewal with the Boulder Airport on

1/15/19. Mike Gulizia will talk to Aidan to get a copy that can be posted on the website.

Mike Gulizia reported that he will provide financial audit results at the March meeting.

New Business

Ken relayed a suggestion from Aidan Sesnic that we include a statement that prohibits sharing of the gate code with any non-members. After discussion, a motion was made by Ken and seconded by Bill Mansfield to put statements in the Field Rules, the Membership Application, and on the Membership Cards. Motion passed.

Ken talked about a new person in the Parks and Recreation hierarchy. Her name is Regina. A good discussion between BAS representatives and Parks and Recreation personnel took place. The topics on the table for consideration are; Hours of Operation improvements, an AMA membership requirement for all fliers, repair of the prairie dog holes, general field maintenance processes, creating field rules based on actual study results, and a desire on both sides to renegotiate our contract with the city.

Ken Jochim relayed that Aidan Sesnic did a Field Safety Audit. He found that some of our tables need maintenance. However, in the meeting with city personnel, they offered to deliver 2 picnic tables to the field at no charge.

Ken Jochim reported that he and Chester Shans went to a Boulder Reservoir meeting. Their feeling from that meeting is that the potential for the city to move our field seems to no longer be in any plan forecast.

Ken reported on some maintenance items from Aidan's notes. We need tape stripes (or better yet paint) on all of the raised concrete edges for safety. There are some faded 'No Parking' signs that need replacement. The sign replacement will be tabled pending discussion with Aidan.

There was some discussion about the BAS brochure versus a possible presence on social media. This subject was tabled pending participation with Aidan.

Ken Jochim reported that he has received our AMA charter, but that it still needs some corrections. He will follow up with AMA.

A motion to adjourn was made by Rudy Glick, seconded by Mike Gulizia and approved at 7:18 pm.


