Indoor Electric Fly-In

Harris Aviation and Things With Wings are hosting what is believed to be the first indoor electric fly-in in Colorado, hosted in Harris Aviation's 13,000+ square foot aircraft storage hangar. The fly-in is to be held on Saturday, Jan 1, 2006, from 9am to 4pm. A \$10.00 charge per pilot will be assessed at the door, and each person can bring and fly as many aircraft as they wish within the 6 hours. There will be door prizes provided by Things With Wings and Horizon Hobbies. The majority of the day will be spent "open flying" and just having fun, but there will be a few entertaining contests such as "electric limbo", and possibly some pylon racing. Should be a great time, and if this is a success, look for it again next year!

To get to the fly-in:

- Hwy. 85 north to 8th St. (Hwy. 66 connects to hwy. 85 just east of I-25)

- East on 8th St.
- North on Airport Road.
- Right turn on Skyhawk.
- Left on Ed Beagles Ln.
- The hangar will be marked using a sign ("Things With Wings").

Parking:

First park on the north and east sides on the fly-in hangar, then park along the east side of Ed Beagles Lane wherever able, not blocking Ed Beagles Lane.

Please note that the facility used is an aircraft storage hangar for local aircraft owners. If the weather turns, such as snow or another really bad wind storm, the event will be forced to reschedule for the following week.
