Mark Bradley showed an ARF Ultimate Bipe by World Models still in the box.

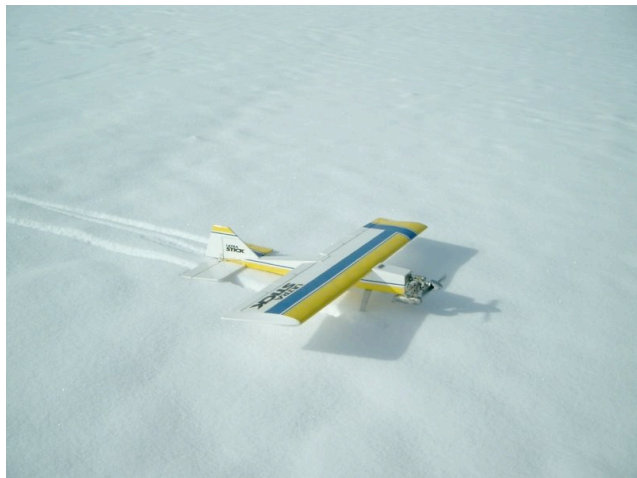
Adjourn
