BAS MEETING MINUTES HOBBY TOWN USA, LONGMONT, CO October 14, 2015

Meeting called to order by **PRESIDENT** Murray Lull at 6:30 pm. with 11 members present. Motion by Dean Ehn, with a second to the motion by Chester Shans, to accept the minutes of the last meeting as they appeared in last month's newsletter. Motion was voted on and passed.

SR. ADVISOR — David Goodnow had no report.

TREASURE REPORT— Dean Ehn gave a detailed report of the Club's finances.

VICE PRESIDENT —Ken Miller expressed "thanks" to all that helped with and participated in the auction of Jim Ewing's RC collection. The Club raised over \$800 from the proceeds of the auction. We, as a Club, express a kind "Thank You" to the Ewing family for their great generosity after Jim's passing.

SECRETARY — Richard Myron noted that recent changes to the Club database program, completed by Al Coelho, will aid in ensuring accuracy in the upcoming annual audit of the club's accounts. Thanks to Al for doing this.

MEMBERSHIP — Tom McKinnon reported, via President Murray Lull, that the Club presently has 94 members, with 25 members participating in the float fly activities. We have one new member this month, Bryan Schneller. Welcome Bryan!

PRESIDENT — Murray Lull discussed the "Downed Aircraft Log", noting that there were 10 entries for the past season. A copy of the log had been sent to the City, as well as a proposal for new recovery procedures, but no response has been received on either point as yet.

Next, Murray remarked that he recently noticed that the Club had a "disabled veteran" dues waiver, and stated that he was happy we had that in place. Additionally, Murray brought up the recent extensive vandalism which occurred at LAMA. Along those lines, David Goodnow brought up a concern over how our own gate lock seems to be incorrectly positioned on the chain on some occasions. Please take care when relocking the gate to get the lock properly positioned on the chain so that the City can have access.

Murray reflected on some recent safety incidents that have occurred involving "quads" being flown from the parking lot, from the taxiway, and even inside the shelter. None of these types of operations is either safe, or allowed, at the field. On site Field Marshals corrected the instances over safety concerns, and instructed the offenders, who were apparently not Club or AMA members, with regard to the field safety rules. Quads should be flown from the helipad.

Finally, Murray reminded all members that the election of officers for the coming calendar year will take place at the December meeting. Interested parties should attend the November meeting, or contact one of the existing officers to get their name placed in nomination. The existing officers will be contacted by Murray with regard to their personal intentions with regard to seeking re-election.

OLD BUSINESS — There was no discussion under old business.

Motion by Rudy Glick, with a second by Dave Goodnow, to adjourn the meeting. Motion voted on and passed. The drawing was held for the \$20 gift card. Mike Gulizia was the lucky winner.
